ضيع The side of a mountain, (S, M, K,) and of an [eminence such as is termed] أَحُهَة. (M.)

: ضَامَة Wronging, or a wrongdoer : pl. ضَامَة : the latter occurring in the prov., تَأْتِى بِكَ الضَّامَة [The wrongdoers bring thee, or cause] عَرْيَسَ الأَسَد
